Key Vocabulary

Tolerance -the ability or willingness to tolerate the existence of opinions or behaviour that one disagrees with.

Respect—due regard for the feelings, wishes, or rights of others.

Acceptance—agreement with or belief in an idea or explanation.

Cultural Diversity—the existence of a variety of cultural or ethnic groups within a society.

Diversity within Leicester's religions:

The religious make up of Leicester is 32.4% Christian, 22.5% No religion, 18.6% Muslim, 15.2% Hindu, 4.4% Sikh, 0.4% Buddhist, 0.1% Jewish, 0.1% Agnostic. (2011 census)
