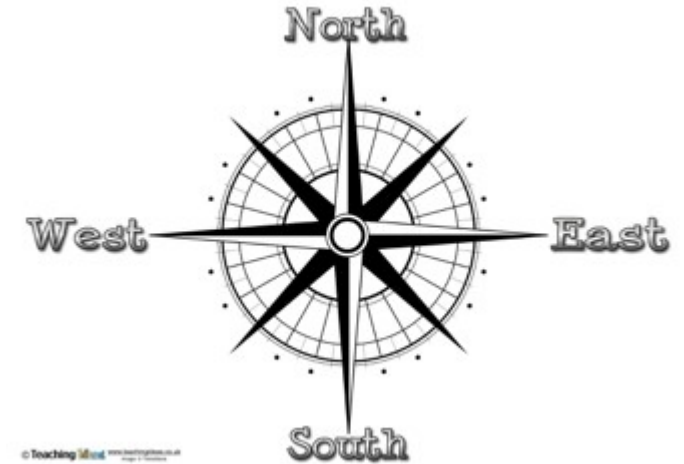




YEAR 1 GEOGRAPHY

Environment	The surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.
Human Features	Human features are things that are built by humans such as, bridges and roads.
Physical Features	Physical Features show natural objects such as mountains and rivers.
Community	A group of people living in the same place/area.
Transport	To take or carry people or goods from one place to another by means of a vehicle, aircraft or ship.
Atlas	A book of maps of the world and charts.
Country	A country is defined as a nation, the people of the nation or land in a rural area.
