Get Reading and Writing

Read a selection of books with your grown-ups at home. Can you recognise any of the words? Can you sound out any of the words? Can you retell the story to your grown up with lots of exciting detail?

Can you write any of your tricky words? Try putting them into a sentence. What other words can you write?



Get Speaking

Talk to your grown ups about what we have been learning in school.

You could tell them about:

- How to speak like a pirate!
- The job of pirates
- The story of the Rainbow Fish
- Ways you can be kind
- Different sea creatures and which one was your favourite



Get Creative

Draw, colour, paint! Find different ways to be creative in your home. Can you practise mixing different colours together? What colours can you make?



Get Mathematical

Can you write any addition or subtraction calculations? Use objects around your household to help to support you with your counting.

Look for different clocks around your house. Can you work out the times?



Draw the different activities you do in a day. What times do you do them? Is it morning, afternoon or in the evening? Order your pictures.

Get Exploring

We have been looking at Spring this term. Look out your window. What nature can you see? What is happening to the trees?

Create a diary of these changes. Note down any differences you see each day. Is it getting lighter? At what time?



Get Online

Can you practise your maths on topmarks.co.uk? We love underwater counting or the toy shop!

Draw a picture on a computer of what you may see in the Spring time. What else could you add?



Get Cooking

Can you follow a simple recipe? Try making fairy cakes or biscuits.

Help your grown-ups with the dinner. Could you write instructions for this so I could make the same dinner?
