<p><b><u>Get Reading</u></b></p> <p>Read some books of your favourite books and tell me which part is your favourite and why.</p> <p>Write down all the split digraphs you find whilst reading these books! How many have you found?</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Speaking</u></b></p> <p>Can you learn how to say and write 'hello' in 7 languages? Can you teach this to someone else?</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Creative</u></b></p> <p>Can you create your very own shield or sword just like Knights used to use in medieval times? Use as many different resources as you can find! Be as creative as possible.</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Mathematical</u></b></p> <p>Can you count in your 2s, 5s and 10s forwards and backwards? Write these down and circle all of the odd numbers in one colour and the even numbers in another.</p> <p>Ask an adult to tell you some 2-digit numbers. Can you write down one more and one less?</p> <p>Go on a 2D and 3D shape hunt around your house. Write down all the shapes you find!</p> 
<p><b><u>Get Exploring</u></b></p> <p>We are looking at seasons this term. Look out your window. What nature can you see? Is there any? Draw a labelled picture to show us.</p> <p>Think about the different types of clothes we might wear in different seasons. Can you draw the clothes we would wear in our current season?</p> <p>How could we look after the environment around us?
