


# Year 6 Homework Pick and Mix

Don't forget to rate it!</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Speaking</u></b></p> <p>Can you learn how to say and write 'Hello, my name is _____. How are you?' in 7 languages? Can you write the response too?</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Creative</u></b></p> <p>This year in art we have researched two of my favourite artists: Banksy and Salvador Dali. Can you create art in the style of one of your favourite artists?</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Mathematical</u></b></p> <p>Your challenge is to create a piece of art that is symmetrical and contains at least 6 obtuse angles.
