<p><b><u>Get Reading</u></b></p> <p>Search and recognise logos - when out on your daily walk – what logos and signs do you recognise? Or use google to see if you recognise any.</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Speaking</u></b></p> <p>Talk about what you remember about learning at school – Use tapestry pictures to help you recall. You could tell them about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Jack and the beanstalk story.</li> <li>• Our farm trip.</li> <li>• What we do in our PE lessons.</li> <li>• People who help us.</li> <li>• Spring changes.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Get Creative</u></b></p> <p>Draw and paint – what can you draw? What can you paint? Can you mix colours?</p> <p>Build and model – use construction to create something exciting!</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Mathematical</u></b></p> <p>Sort your toys in to categories – How many of each thing do you have?</p> <p>Look at time and routine – what happens in the morning, what happens in the afternoon? What happens in the evening?</p> <p>Draw shapes and create shape pictures? What shapes did you use for a rocket picture? What shapes did you use for a person picture?</p>
<p><b><u>Get Exploring</u></b></p> <p>Find a magnet at home – then find out which things are magnetic and which things are not?</p> <p>Fill the sink or bath with water – which things float and which things sink?</p>	<p><b><u>Get Online</u></b></p> <p>Watch ‘Dramatots’ on YouTube – they have a fun music and movement class at 10am during the weekdays.</p> <p>Draw a picture on a computer of what you may see in the Spring time. What else could you add?</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Cooking</u></b></p> <p>Can you make a sandwich? What is in your sandwich? What things did you use to make it?</p> <p>Can you make Easter cornflake cakes?</p> 	<p><b><u>Character muscles</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Teamwork</u></b> – work together to clean up your toys or help your grown-ups.</p> <p><b><u>Problem Solving</u></b>– Can you master a tricky jigsaw or doing up your coat or buttons?</p> <p><b><u>Peace</u></b> – Can you try out cosmic yoga on YouTube for some time to relax?</p>
