


Nursery Activities Pick and Mix

| <p><u>Get Reading</u></p> <p>Write out the sounds that we have learnt so far in phonics – m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, o, g. Now find things in your house that you can hear start with those sounds. E.g. m- mop, a – apple, s- sock, d- door.</p>  | <p><u>Get Speaking</u></p> <p>Talk about what you have planned for the day... What would you all like to do? Maybe make a wish list for the week with activities and jobs for all to do!</p> <p>Monday: Jigsaws and cleaning the bedrooms.</p> <p>Tuesday: Painting and doing the washing</p> <p>Wednesday: Going on a walk and Hoovering the house.</p> | <p><u>Get Creative</u></p> <p>Create some puppets – use sticks and paper or old socks?</p> <p>Can you make a short puppet show with your new characters?</p>  | <p><u>Get Mathematical</u></p> <p>Can you make a hopscotch – or number line and jump on the numbers, saying them as you see them?</p> <p>Can you do the same with drawing different shapes to jump on?</p>  |
| <p><u>Get Exploring</u></p> <p>During a walk or in your garden – collect some nature items.</p> <p>What have you found? Can you stick them to paper to make a nature picture?</p>  | <p><u>Get Online</u></p> <p>Research about a topic that interests you with an adult – Maybe animals, space and the solar system or a place in the world.</p> <p>What did you find out? Can you make a poster about the facts you found out?</p>  | <p><u>Get Cooking</u></p> <p>Can you help to make a special dinner for your family?</p> <p>Maybe you could take pictures of you cooking and create a recipe book.</p>  | <p><u>Character muscles</u></p> <p><u>Kindness</u> – Can you draw a picture and put it in your window for all to see? Or post it to somebody special to cheer them up?</p> <p><u>Resilience</u>: You are all already being resilient with the changes that are happening but keep trying to do something you find difficult whilst at home. E.g. writing your name, riding your bike.</p> |
