

## Year 1 Homework Pick and Mix


### Get Reading

### Get Mathematical

### Get Exploring

How many plants can you think of that we can eat? Which part of the plant can we eat? Roots? Stem? Flower? Leaf? Or all of them?

#### **Floating and Sinking.**

Can you choose a variety of different objects from around your house? Predict which objects you think will float and sink and then test them. Were your predictions correct?
