<p><u>Get Reading</u></p> <p>Pirates and Islands would have been our new topic this term. See if you can find a book – fiction or non-fiction about pirates and read that. If you have read a non-fiction book write down 5 new facts that you have learnt. If you have read a fiction book, try and write a book review. There are some examples on Twitter that the teachers have written!</p> <p>You could look on MYON to see if they have a story about pirates.</p> 	<p><u>Get Speaking</u></p> <p>See if you can print off the poem 'Percy the Pirate'. Read it through so you are really familiar with it. Practise reading it out loud. When you are ready, perform it for the people in your house. Think about what we have learnt about performing. You might want to use some props and even dress up as a pirate to perform it!</p> 	<p><u>Get Creative</u></p> <p>Make your own pirate face using a paper plate or a paper bowl. If you can't find a paper plate or bowl you could just use cardboard from a cereal box.</p> 	<p><u>Get Mathematical</u></p> <p>Make some place value equipment using things you have around the house. Ideas of things you could use are straws, lollipop sticks, dry spaghetti, cotton buds.</p> <p>Once you have done this pick a 2 digit number and make it using your place value equipment. What would one more and one less than your number be? What would ten more or ten less than your number be?</p> 
<p><u>Get Exploring</u></p> <p>Explore around your house and your garden and see if you can make an A-Z of things you can find.</p> <p>Here is an extra challenge for you – they have got to be able to fit on a dinner plate!</p> 	<p><u>Get Online</u></p> <p>Continue to use ictgames.com and topmarks.co.uk to remind yourself of all the things we have learnt in Maths and Literacy so far!</p> <p>Remember to log on to Times Tables Rock Stars to practise your times tables.</p> 	<p><u>Get Cooking</u></p> <p>Bake some biscuits and see if you can decorate them to look like pirates.</p> <p>When you have finished, see if you can write a set of instructions for someone else to follow.</p> 	<p><u>Character Muscles</u></p> <p>The character muscle for the next week is 'resilience'</p> <p>We are all having to show a lot of resilience at the moment. Make a poster to show how you are demonstrating this character muscle.</p>
