<p><u>Get Reading and writing</u></p> <p>Can you write a list for your family shopping – you could include drawings, initial sounds or copy words for the list.</p> 	<p><u>Get Speaking</u></p> <p>Play a question game...</p> <p>What is your address? What is your favourite fruit? What is your favourite number? What is your favourite colour? Who is in your family? Who are your friends? Where is your favourite place to go?</p>	<p><u>Get Creative</u></p> <p>What can you make out of a box? Can you make a house? A car?
