Nursery Activities Pick and Mix



Get Reading and Writing

Can you practise writing your name? You could write in chalk outside, with paint, in flour or in shampoo during your bath!

You could also try writing the initial sound of your family member's names too.



Get Speaking

Draw pictures of emotions – can you talk about what happens when you feel each emotion? When do you feel happy? When do you feel sad?

Get Creative

Can you create an assault course for either you or your toys to do?

You could use a toilet roll tube for a small toy to crawl through

Or you could create an assault course for yourself – you could use jumping on the cushions, balancing on a scarf...

Get Mathematical

Can you go outside and find lots of sticks...

How many have you found?

Can you lay them out longest to shortest?

Can you use them to make shape pictures?

Or numerals?



Get Exploring

Can you explore different ways you can balance things? You can balance a beanbag or soft toy on your head? On your shoulder? On your foot?

Can you walk slowly with something balancing on your head?



Get Online

Can you use a word programme or maybe an email and practise typing. You could type your name, your age or maybe type the teachers a letter.

Get Cooking

Can you create a picture with food items – Miss Moore-Haines loves to do this with fruit.

<u>Good Humour</u> Continue to laugh and joke – find some child friendly jokes and silly rhymes to share together.
