





Nursery Activities Pick and Mix



<p><u>Get Reading and writing</u></p> <p>Explore a new story you haven't read before – use the oxford owl login on the school website or use YouTube and search a story with the word “read aloud”</p>	<p><u>Get Speaking</u></p> <p>Play a talking game – What am I – use picture cards or draw pictures to play on the persons head then the players take it in turns to guess what they are by asking questions.</p> 	<p><u>Get Creative</u></p> <p>Make a garden ornament / wind chime... for your own garden or bring it to school to help us decorate the playgrounds.</p> <p>You could paint rocks, create a wind chime, make pom pom hangers?</p>	<p><u>Get Mathematical</u></p> <p>Talk about weight – use the language of heavy and light to compare things in your home.</p> <p>Collect a few items to compare...</p> 
<p><u>Get Exploring</u></p> <p>Explore shadows – get a torch and explore how to make shadows or use the sunshine – what shapes can you make?
