Tapestry

Tapestry is the online learning journal that we use to assess your child and share your child's learning with you.

Should there be a whole school closure or bubble closure, your child in EYFS will be expected to complete the uploaded work on Tapestry and engage with remote learning via this platform.

If you require support in uploading to Tapestry, please visit the EYFS section of the school website to access the Tapestry guides. If you have trouble signing in to your child's Tapestry account, please email your child's class email and a member of staff will support you.

Expectations

Tasks for your child will be posted daily.

9am—a phonics based task

10am—a literacy based task

11am—a maths based task

1pm—a topic based task

2pm—a task based on your child's individual learning needs.

Attendance will be recorded by an adult liking or commenting on the first Tapestry post by 9.30am each morning.

The above tasks will need to be completed and uploaded daily for the team to view by 3pm.

Non-engagemet in following this will be referred to the Principal or the Senior Leadership Team.

If you have a valid reason for non attendance in accessing the remote learning you will need to email your child's class email by 9.30am each day.

Daily Tasks:

The tasks will always be Engaging, purposeful and at an accessible level for your child's learning.

They will include the materials sent home in the work pack or general household resources such as, spoons.

If you ever have difficulties in completing the work it is important that you inform a member of staff by emailing your child's class email as soon as possible. This way the staff cans support you and the child to access the work.
