| Jesus | The central figure of the Christian religion |
| Church | A place of worship for Christians |
| Parable | An earthly story with a heavenly meaning that Jesus used to teach his followers |
| Miracle | An extraordinary event |

- To be able to recount a parable and a miracle and understand the message for Christians.
- To know that a church is a special place for a Christian and identify some artefacts found in a church
