Hello all,

The children have continued to impress us with their positivity and enthusiasm about being back learning in school.

This week, staff have spent time reflecting on the past year and the changes that we have been required to make at Knighton Mead. Some of these have been, even though as a response to the global pandemic, we may keep!

Covid Testing Reminder—if your child displays coronavirus symptoms as outlined on government guidance (persistent cough, high temperature or change in taste/smell), please book a PCR test. The whole household should self-isolate. Please do not send your child or their siblings into school. Please don't use the Lateral Flow Devices (LFD) with anyone who is experiencing symptoms as these are for asymptomatic older people (age 12+).

Please continue to keep the school office informed of any test results, both positive and negative. Thank you for your ongoing support and for working so well alongside us to ensure we keep our community as safe as possible.

Uniform will continue to be optional at Knighton Mead until May half term when I will review again. Please do not feel you need to buy uniform and go out to shops unnecessarily. A reminder that jewellery should still not be worn by children, even if they choose not to wear uniform items.

Next Wednesday, we are taking part in the Hindu festival of Holi which is the following weekend. This is an exciting and fun festival which celebrates colour. We invite all children to come in bright clothes on this day.
