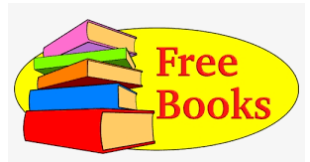
Finally, a huge thank you for such a joyous Summer Fair this week and for some fabulous attendance across the whole school too!
