School photos will be taken on Tuesday 26th September. If you would like photos with siblings who do not attend the school, then please come to the school office at 8 a.m.



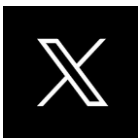
Finally, EYFS would be grateful of any donations of children's underwear, socks or trousers / leggings - ranging from age 2 years - 6 years.
