This week was Maths Story Day. Across the school, the children read The Nativity Story and completed maths-based activities around this.

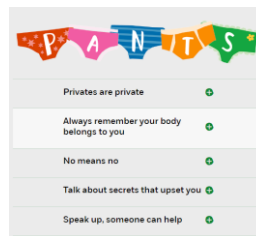
We are always reviewing our safeguarding provision and it is time for our annual survey. Please complete the following short survey so that we can look at ways to improve our provision.

There have been several concerns raised by parents about some Year 5 and 6 children hanging around the gates at the start of the day. At times, they are not showing a good awareness of road safety nor respect towards others. This is a reminder that the gates do not open until 8:40am and there are no staff supervising before this time.
