You said, we listened...

From the parent survey, many of you would like to know more details about how your children are getting on in school and ways in which you can help them to improve academically. From the new year, all year groups will have Tapestry. This is a way for parents to keep up to date with the learning that is happening in school, and you can also post the things that you do at home so that we are able to share this with the children. A reminder of the ways that you can help your child at home:

- Encourage them to read daily find a time and quiet space (if possible!), share a book together or listen to
 your child read. If they prefer to read alone, ask them about what they have read.
- Practise mental arithmetic we subscribe to Times Tables Rockstars and Numbots. These are online tools
 that support children with their mental maths skills. 10 minutes a day at home would have a huge impact on
 their abilities in school.
- Practise spellings some children will have Red Word Challenge books with spellings to practise and some will have Edshed. If you can support your child with this over the week then it makes such a big difference to their writing in school.
