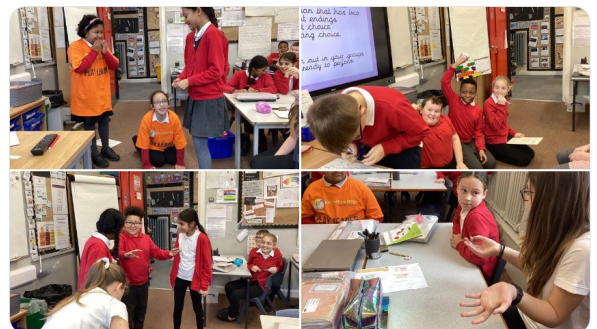
Please note that the ‘English for Parents’ course is for 6 weeks and will continue after the Easter Holidays.

We are starting next week with ‘Keeping Your Child Safe Online’ - please call the office by 6.2.24 to book on this course and for any of the others – remember the courses are free.

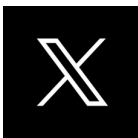
