

Summer HAF 2025

Children and young people who receive benefits related free school meals can take part in our free holiday activities and food (HAF) programme over the summer holiday.

The programme sessions will include a variety of activities, such as art, sport and music and a healthy meal will be provided each day your child attends.

This summer, eligible children can receive a **maximum of four weeks** of free activities and food. Our programmes are either a:

- HAF programme Week long programme that runs for four days, unless stated. Children will receive a healthy meal each day they attend.
- Gym / boxing pass Multiple use passes for 14 to 16 year olds with supplementary food voucher (max 16 vouchers in total), unless stated.

Before you register, please consider the:

- Programme type HAF programme or gym / boxing pass
- · Location of the programme and how your child will get there
- · Days and the time of the programme
- Age range of the programme

And avoid registering for:

- · More than one programme provider for the same week
- · More than four weeks of programmes

Registration is made direct to the HAF providers. Registration closes on Friday 27 June 2025.
